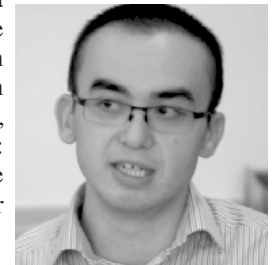
A forum on Executive Order 9066, which led to over 100,000 Americans being put in internment camps, included family members of internees and community activists connecting 1942 to today.
