I hope you are having a good week. I just wanted to check in on two items:

1) Does IPR staff know about the plan to direct Mr. Handelman to film and sit in the public section of our meeting room, for future CRC meeting? I wonder if they may have some suggestions as to how best to handle this. I appreciate you handling this and noting my concern that it makes me uncomfortable to have Mr. Handelman basically right "onstage" with us and just a few feet from our table.

2) Do you plan to remind CRC members to direct their technical/policy questions to the City Attorney and IPR staff vs Copwatch? We both noted, in our last meeting, that CRC members were addressing Copwatch for
